Jeff Miller Raises Over \$272,000 on First Report

Mission Viejo, CA - - Republican Assembly candidate Jeff Miller will report today that he has raised \$272,051 for his campaign for the 71st Assembly District. Miller, the Mayor Pro Tem of Corona, is the leading GOP candidate to succeed Assemblyman Todd Spitzer.

"Rather than going after the low hanging fruit first, Jeff took the opposite approach and went outside his Riverside County base to raise most of these funds. That means his next report will be even more impressive," said Gilliard.
